SCRIPTURE: JAMES 5:16-20

16 Confess your trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person is very powerful in its effect. 17 Elijah was a man with a nature like ours, and he prayed earnestly that it would not rain; and it did not rain on the land for three years and six months. 18 And he prayed again, and the heaven gave rain, and the earth produced its fruit.

19 Brethren, if anyone among you wanders from the truth, and someone turns him back, 20 let [the restorer] know that he who turns a sinner from the error of his way will save a soul from death and cover a multitude of sins.
