2. Read 1 Timothy 2:11-12. Is there anything unclear about these verses? Why does our culture have such a hard time receiving this instruction? Why do so many in the church struggle with this? (1 Tim. 3:1-2; Titus 1:7; 2:3-4) Is God’s way always best?

3. Read 1 Timothy 2:13-14. In what way was woman responsible for the Fall? Who was created first? What does this signify? Why do these verses say that Adam was not deceived? Which is worse? What implications does this have on the human race? (1 Tim. 2:13; Gen. 2:18; 1 Cor. 11:8-9; Gen. 3:1-7; Rom. 5:12)

4. Read 1 Timothy 2:15. What are the really bad interpretations? Is there any validity in them at all? Why not? (Gen. 35:19; Matt. 8:25; 9:21-22; 10:22; 24:22; 27:40, 42, 49; Eph. 2:8-9; Rom. 10:9)

5. Which of the three possible views do you take? Why? (Gen. 3:15; Rom. 16:20; Lk. 1:34-35; Col. 3:15; Gen. 3:16; Gen. 3:1-7, 15-16; Titus 2:3-4; 1 Tim. 5:14) Which view was presented as most likely in the sermon? What was the biggest thing you learned in all this discussion?
