1. Read Galatians 4:4a. What is the significance of this verse being the fulfillment of Scripture? Where was the first time in the Bible where there is a prophecy about the coming Messiah? (Gen. 3:15)

2. Read Gen. 12:1-3; Gal. 3:8-11; 2 Sam. 7:12, 16; Jer. 31:31-34. What are these passages pointing to? How were they all fulfilled in Jesus?

3. Read Galatians 4:4b. What is this part of the verse saying? What is the significance of Jesus being born to a virgin? (Isa. 7:14; Matt. 1:18, 22-23)

4. Read 1 Peter 2:22, 1 John 3:5, and Hebrews 4:15. What is the significance of Jesus being born under the Law? What does Jesus’ life demonstrate?

5. Read Galatians 4:5. How was the perfect result found in redemption? What does this mean? How is this worked out in your life? (Gal. 3:13-14; Rom. 3:23; 6:23)

6. Read Rom. 8:15; 1 Pet. 1:4. What is the significance of the perfect result also being worked out in adoption? What is this biblical doctrine? How is this practically worked out in your life?

7. Read the take home questions. Which one encourages you or challenges you the most? Why? How will you live your life differently this week based on what you have learned from this passage?
