6. Imagine being Jesus' mother or Mary Magdalene, what would have been running through their minds as they watched Jesus upon the cross?
7. Jesus tells John to take care of his mother. How is that an important look at how the church is supposed to function? How might you live out the implications of that moment?
8. Before Jesus takes his last breath, he says, "It is finished." What all was actually finished?
