<u>December 24: Christmas Eve Services</u> will be at 10AM & 5PM. Youth Group will be cancelled that evening.


<u>December 31: New Years Eve</u> service will be at 10AM. Youth Group will be cancelled that evening.

## **Further Reflection for 12/17**

- 1. Have you ever had a moment in which you felt joy that didn't make sense in your circumstances? If so, to what do you attribute that joy?
- 2. Read 1 Thessalonians 5:16-24
- 3. What jumps out to you from the text?
- 4. Paul gives a practical list of things that likely would change the essence of who we are if we embraced them. Which ones for you would be easy and which would be difficult?
- 5. Verse 24 reminds us that Jesus is faithful and he will do it. What is it that Paul is saying Jesus will do and why is that important? What role do we play in that?
- 6. Read Philippians 4:4-9
- 7. What jumps out to you from the text?
- 8. What are the similarities from both passages? How might that be an important part to following Jesus?
- 9. You will notice Paul talks often about our hearts, or about what we dwell on, why might it be important for us to think about what we love and where we place focus?
- 10. What are practices you could put in to your daily life that would lead to living out the list of what Paul writes here?
