Further Reflection for 10/30

Reflection:

- 1. When is a moment you put your hope in something that after the fact you realized it was a bad place to put your hope?
- 2. What has been a moment in life a life experience caused you to change how you were living?

Study:

- 1. Read Revelation 6-9 (at a minimum read 7:1-4, 9-17; 8:1-5)
 - a. What jumps out to you from the text?
 - b. Are there any images/illustrations that John writes that reminded you of other biblical texts? If so, which ones?
 - c. In both Revelation 5 and 7, John hears one thing and sees another. In chapter 5 he hears lion and sees lamb. What is it he hear and see in chapter 7?
 - d. Read Deuteronomy 6:4-9 and then re-read Revelation 7:3. What might their connection be?
 - e. What is the picture that is being painted in 8:3-4 in regards to prayer?
 - f. Revelation 9 is filled with the repercussions of people choosing their own paths and what that brings about. Read 9:20-21. Why do people still choose their own way when it leads to more destruction?
 - g. What is the primary thing that marks your life?

Application:

1. What is one step you can make to be more marked by the Lamb rather than the empire?

Prayer:

Father, help me to recognize you have done and are doing through your Son. Help me to have ears and eyes that line up with the way you see the world. May I learn to fully put my hope in you. In Jesus' name I Pray. Amen.

Spiritual Practice:

- Begin each day this week thinking on where you are putting hope.
- End each day this week reflecting on the source of your hope.
