Further Reflection for 5/16

- 1. Read 1 John 5:9-13
- 2. Whose story (testimony of life) has most shaped your life? Whose faith testimony has most shaped your life (it could be the same person)?
- 3. Who's the most influential person in your faith journey in these days and why?
- 4. Share your testimony of how God has been at work in your life? If applicable, share how you came to follow Jesus?
- 5. The idea of a testimony/story being told by God may catch us off balance a little, but John is trying to say that God's testimony is given through Jesus and through his followers. What makes that appealing to you and what gives you pause?
- 6. What are testimony's that are sometimes difficult to believe?
- 7. John says that the testimony of God is His Son and that through Jesus we can have eternal life (life connected to God now and always). John even writes that the reason he wrote these words is so that his readers could have that life.
- 8. Have you ever shared your testimony of following Jesus? (a helpful thing is to be able to share who we were before we came to follow Jesus, what led to us following Jesus, and how Jesus is continually shaping our life). If you have, how did it go?
- 9. Why might it be important for us to always be able to share our testimony of faith?
- 10. Pray this week, "Father, help me to be follow your son. May I have the courage to share my testimony of what you have done in my life. Help me to live faithfully to the life that you have invited me into, to know eternal life now. In Jesus' name I pray, Amen."
