

APPLICATION GUIDE

Use the questions below for personal reflection or discussion with your family or friends as we seek to not only hear the Word but believe it and live accordingly.

1. When does the work God has called you to do feel like important work? When does it feel unimportant? Does the work you do often give you the satisfaction of seeing a task completed?
2. Read **Nehemiah 6:1-9**. How did Nehemiah respond to the distractions to the important work he was doing? Nehemiah prayed that God would strengthen his hands for the work that needed to get done (see v.9). How often do you pray for God to strengthen you to do the work He has called you to do? In what specific ways should you pause to pray and ask Him to strengthen you right now?
3. In **Nehemiah 6:10-14**, there is an attempt to deceive Nehemiah in a way that would lead him to fear and then to sin. In what ways do you see the progression in your own life of lies leading to fear leading to sin? In what ways has fear crippled you and caused you to fail to obey God? Rejecting the lies and choosing instead to trust God's truth and act in obedience requires the help of the Holy Spirit in discernment and knowing God's Word. Ask God for help in being discerning and commit to being a faithful student of God's Word so that you can know what's true.
4. In **Nehemiah 7**, we see the focus of the book shift from the work of rebuilding the wall (**Nehemiah 6:15**) to the work of renewing the people. In the chapters that follow. Read ahead in **Nehemiah 8** and take note of how God is at work through His Word.
5. Why was Jesus' reaction to Peter in **Matthew 16:21-23** so strong? Why does that matter for us?

COMING BACK AND BUILDING UP

*What kind of work has God called you to do?
Does it seem important to others?
