Hebrew 4:13

Hebrews 4:13 KJV: "Neither is there any creature that is not manifest in His sight: but all things are naked and opened unto the eyes of Him with whom we have to do."

Hebrews 4:13 CEV: "Nothing is hidden from God! He sees through everything, and we will have to tell Him the truth."

Hebrews 4:13 TLB: "He knows about everyone, everywhere. Everything about us is bare and wide open to the all-seeing eyes of our living God; nothing can be hidden from Him to whom we must explain all that we have done."
