JOHN 15:1-16 part 6

"Cleansing"

John 15:2 AMPC: "Any branch in Me that does not bear fruit [that stops bearing] He cuts away (trims off, takes away); and He cleans and repeatedly prunes every branch that continues to bear fruit, make it bear more and richer and more excellent fruit."

✂ **NOTE TWO THINGS ABOUT FRUIT-BEARING:**

- a. The fruit a believer is to _____ (produce).

🌀 What does it mean to say a Christian is to bear fruit? It means

- to bear _____. "...I wanted to come so that I could help you grow spiritually [harvest some fruit among you] as I have helped the other..." (Romans 1:13 EXB) or "...I want to work among you and see spiritual fruit..." (NLT)

- to bear _____. “What fruit did you have then from the things of which you are now ashamed? The result of those things is death. But now, having been freed from sin and having become slaves of God, you have fruit unto holiness, and the end is eternal life. For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.” (Romans 6:21-23)
- to bear Christian _____ or the fruit of the _____. “But the fruit of the [Holy] Spirit [the work which His presence within accomplishes] is LOVE, JOY (gladness), PEACE, PATIENCE (an even temper, forbearance), KINDNESS, GOODNESS (benevolence), FAITHFULNESS, GENTLENESS (meekness, humility), SELF-CONTROL (self-restraint, continence). Against such things there is no law [that can bring a charge].” (Galatians 5:22-23 AMPC) Interesting what the Message Bible quotes: “But what happens when we live God’s way? He brings gifts into our lives, much the same way that fruit appears in an ORCHARD—things like affection for others (love), exuberance about life (joy), serenity (peace). We DEVELOP a willingness to stick with things (patience), a sense of compassion in the heart (kindness), and a conviction that a basic holiness permeates things and people (goodness). We find ourselves INVOLVED in loyal commitments (faithfulness), not need to force our way in life (gentleness), able to marshal and direct our energies wisely (self-control).”

b. The different stages of fruit-bearing. There are degrees of fruit-bearing, of _____ and _____ to Christ. Matthew 13:8 EXB quotes: “Some other seed fell on good ground where it grew and produced a crop [grain]. Some plants made a 100 times more, some made 60 times more, and some made 30 times more.”
