

"New Year, New Perspective"

Intro:

Even though our societal norms*change*, the Word of God is *changeless*, Matt. 5:18.

Most New Years resolutions revolve around *physical* things.

While setting goals is *good*, they must fit within the *framework* of scripture, within the parameters of our *gifts* and *calling*.

I. Remember Who Owns You

God *owns* us because He *purchased* us with Christ's blood.

We are His *slaves* dulos (Gk.) 1 Peter 1:18-19; 1 Cor. 6:19.

We are a *people* of His own *possession*, 1 Peter 2:9.

II. Renew Our Oath of Obedience

We are *saved* to be brought into *obedience* to Christ. 1 Peter1:2.

When we *confess* Jesus as Lord, we were *declaring* an oath of *obedience*, Ex. 24:3-8.

III. Remain Faithful to Biblical Convictions

We are to make sure:

- 1. Our doctrine is sound,
- 2. Our convictions are strong
- **3.** We are to be mentally strong and *spiritually* courageous.

IV. Recognize All Sin is a Violation of a Relationship.

Sin for a Christian is not just *violating* an objective *law*, it's breeching our *relationship* with God.

All sin is against *God*, it *interferes* with our relationship with Him, it puts us at *enmity* with Him. 1 Pet. 3:10-12.

V. Render Love Always to Others

Worldly love is often out of sentimentality, or from a fraternal relationship.

Christian Love is a *choice*, *sacrificial* in nature. Our lives are to be *marked* by love. Jn. 13:35.

VI. Regard Highly the Effects of Adversity

Our various *trials* are given to *prove* our faith is genuine. 1 Peter 1:7.

Our trials drive us back to the Shepherd, 1 Pet. 2:25.

We are to *glorify* God in our trials. 1 Pet. 4:16.

VII. Recognize the Supreme Purpose of Your Life.

We are to worship God in our:

- 1. Minds,
- 2. Through song,
- **3.** In our *behavior*. 1 Peter 2:4-5.

We are to *proclaim* the *excellencies* of God.
