 - e. When is a moment that you have sensed your heart "burning" because of an encounter with Jesus?
 - f. Why do you think the disciples on the road did not know it was Jesus?

1. Where do you need God to "resurrect" something in you?
2. How might the resurrection of Jesus help you do live differently?

Prayer:

Father, thank you for conquering sin and death. Help me to live as a person of the resurrection. In Jesus' name I Pray. Amen.
