## **Further Reflection for 9/1**

- 1. When is a moment in life that you felt overwhelmed by something that was good/bad?
- 2. Read John 12:20-50
- 3. What jumps out to you from the text?
- 4. How might you understand versus 24-26? What does it mean to lose your life?
- 5. Verses 31-33 paint a picture of Jesus' death and how that is ultimately what overcomes the forces of darkness in the world. Versus 34-36 show the rebuttal of those listening as they cannot imagine God's Savior dying. Their imaginations are geared toward violent overthrow. How does Jesus' message paint a different picture and how might we embrace that message now?
- 6. Verses 37-43 show that many didn't believe in Jesus, but many did believe in Jesus. Why, even today is it difficult/easy to believe in Jesus?
- 7. This passage ends (v 44-50) with a reminder that Jesus came to save the world. It also shares that those who reject his teaching and don't follow him, have chosen their own judgment. How do we understand both of these realities at the same time?
- 8. The brighter a light is, the more pronounced shadows are. This week, ask the light of Jesus to shine more brightly in your life, so that, the areas that you need his light to shine will be more evident. Then ask God to help you surrender those areas of life.
