A Psalm of David

- 1 Do not fret because of evildoers,
Nor be envious of the workers of iniquity.
- 2 For they shall soon be cut down like the grass,
And wither as the green herb.
- 3 Trust in the LORD, and do good;
Dwell in the land, and feed on His faithfulness.
- 4 Delight yourself also in the LORD,
And He shall give you the desires of your heart.
- 5 Commit your way to the LORD,
Trust also in Him,
And He shall bring it to pass.
- 6 He shall bring forth your righteousness as the light,
And your justice as the noonday.
- 7 Rest in the LORD, and wait patiently for Him;
Do not fret because of him who prospers in his way,
Because of the man who brings wicked schemes to pass.
- 8 Cease from anger, and forsake wrath;
Do not fret—it only causes harm.
- 9 For evildoers shall be cut off;
But those who wait on the LORD,
They shall inherit the earth.
- 10 For yet a little while and the wicked shall be no more;
Indeed, you will look carefully for his place,
But it shall be no more.
- 11 But the meek shall inherit the earth,
And shall delight themselves in the abundance of peace.
