CALL TO WORSHIP – Psalm 146:1-5

Praise the LORD, O my soul! I will praise the LORD as long as I live. I will sing praises to my God while I have my being. Put not your trust in princes, in a son of man, in whom there is no salvation. When his breath departs, he returns to the earth. On that very day his plans perish. Blessed is he whose help is the God of Jacob, whose hope is in the LORD his God.

PRAYER OF ADORATION, PRAISE, AND THANKS

In your own words, pray to God and praise him for who he is and what he has done. If you are with your family, you can take turns thinking of things to praise and thank God for, especially how you can thank him for this past week.

CALL TO CONFESSION (Unison) – From Psalm 139:1-7

“O Lord, you have searched me and known me! You know when I sit down and when I rise up; you discern my thoughts from afar. You search out my path and my lying down and are acquainted with all my ways. Even before a word is on my tongue, behold, you know it altogether. You hem me in, behind and before, and lay your hand upon me. Such knowledge is too wonderful for me; it is high; I cannot attain it. Where shall I go from your Spirit? Or where shall I flee from your presence?”

INVITATION TO SILENT CONFESSION

Knowing that God knows every thought in our minds, every attitude of our hearts, and every word from our mouths, let us confess our sins before him and find mercy in Jesus Christ. *(Take time to silently confess your sins)*

ASSURANCE OF PARDON – Acts 10:43

“To him all the prophets bear witness that everyone who believes in him receives forgiveness of sins through his name.”
