Orientation in a Disoriented World



Further Reflection for 10/13

1. Has there ever been a moment when what you built your life around fell apart? Or has there been a time when the thing you looked to changed in such a way that you were disoriented?
2. Read John 16:1-15
3. What jumps out to you from the text?
4. What were the things that Jesus said so that people would not fall away? (hint: you need to look backward from verse 1 of chapter 16)
5. Imagine being the disciples and hearing that the place that their life centered around was no longer going to be a safe place for them. What would be that place for you? How would you feel?
6. Jesus says he must go away so that the Advocate (Holy Spirit) can come. Why was it necessary for Jesus to go away?
7. How can we understand sin, righteousness, and judgment based on verses 8-11?
8. This passage ends with Jesus letting his followers know that the Holy Spirit will not bring about any message that Jesus doesn't affirm. How can we determine if something comes from the Holy Spirit or from somewhere else?
9. What are the next steps needed in your life to make Jesus the foundation of your life so that He becomes your place of orientation?
10. This week, spend time in prayer asking God to help you sense his Spirit's presence so that he becomes your foundation. Ask what might need to be dropped or added in your life to bring you closer to Jesus.
