## **Further Reflection for 6/27**

- Read each passage and reflect on the way you see God calling people to holiness. Seek to understand how the laws were understood in relationship with love of God.
- 2. Read Leviticus 11:44-45, 19:2, and 20:26 what is the emphasis?
- 3. Read Deuteronomy 6:4-9, can you make any connections between these words and what we see Jesus saying in the New Testament? How might we embody the heart of this text within our families and spheres of influence?
- 4. Read Deuteronomy 10:16 and 30:6. How might we understand what the writer of Deuteronomy is wanting us to know? How might this point forward to Jesus?
- 5. Read Hebrews 8:6-13 and 10:14-18. What connections between these texts do you see in the other texts above? What connection do you see to the Law of the Old Testament?
- 6. What value do you find in understanding the law of the Old Testament?
- 7. Pray this prayer: "Father, help me to be defined by love for you and to live out that love. Help me to live a life of holiness because you are holy. In Jesus' name I pray, Amen."
