God's Good News Story: The Church Alive & Growing The State of the Church Address

We begin today with Year Three of "God's Good News Story". Our focus this year is on the remainder of the New Testament from Acts to Revelation. Our theme is

"The Church Alive & Growing"

Acts 2: 42-47... ⁴² They were continually devoting themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer. ⁴³ Everyone kept feeling a sense of awe; and many wonders and signs were taking place through the apostles. ⁴⁴ And all the believers were together and had all things in common; ⁴⁵ and they would sell their property and possessions and share them with all, to the extent that anyone had need. ⁴⁶ Day by day continuing with one mind in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, they were taking their meals together with gladness and sincerity of heart, ⁴⁷ praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord was adding to their number day by day those who were being saved.

Today I am using the theme of the traditional "State of the Union Address" that Presidents give. I am sharing with you a 'State of the Church' address.

So, what is "The Church" anyway.

For our purposes, we are simplifying the usage of the word church into two (2) fundamental meanings. (1) The Universal Church and (2) The Local Church.

The Universal church is a term that refers to the Church

throughout the world as a whole. It is also a concept that describes the heavenly and eschatological assembly of everyone who belongs to Christ's new covenant and kingdom. The universal church includes all Christians from past, present, and future, and is the body of Christ, the family of God, and the temple of the Spirit. (9marks.org)

The Local Church then is a local, temporal, subdivisions of the Universal Church that agree to work cooperatively in a localized area to do the work, mission, and task of God's Kingdom. This is what we, as the First Baptist Church of Broussard are to be and do – We are to join the everyday Mission of God and to do the work of extending the Kingdom of God in love and faithfulness.

First Baptist Church of Broussard Church History (NOTE: 18 photo slides from history file)

First Baptist Church, Broussard, began in 1955 when Northside Baptist Church, under the direction of Reverend St. Clair Bower, became interested in missions. Two ladies from their Adult Training Union conducted a survey of the small but strategic suburb of Lafayette. In June of that year a tent revival was held with Brother Bower preaching in English and Rev. Amadie Janice, Louisiana Baptist Convention missionary, preaching in French. Another revival was held in 1956 which resulted in the establishment of the mission in Broussard. The old bank building on Morgan Street was rented for their services. In 1957 a Catholic lady consented to sell the property on the corner of South Morgan and Monroe Streets to the

Baptist group. Construction of an education/sanctuary facility was planned under the direction of the builder, Elroy Jones. By June of 1958 the building was completed and on June 22 an Open House was held. On September 21, 1958, the mission was organized as a Southern Baptist Church with 34 members and an annual budget of \$3000. Reverend Elroy Jones was called as the first pastor. The Children's Education/Fellowship Hall Building which was a steel building donated by Highland Baptist Church in New Iberia, Louisiana in the early 1970's. In October of 1977, the present sanctuary was built with a seating capacity of 400+. The Refuge (formerly The Lighthouse/ Bowman Lumber Building) was purchased around 1993. In December of 1993, the new Educational Building was dedicated. Rev. Weldon Moak became pastor in July of 2007. In 2012 the Sanctuary was remodeled. Bro. Adam Whitney became Associate Pastor of Education/Youth/Music on April 1, 2009. Mrs. Vicki Tilley became our Preschool & Children's Director in 2016.
