Further Reflection for 3/3

- 1. When is a moment you look back and know you should have done something, but did not do it?
- Read John 19:1-16a
- 3. What jumps out to you from the text?
- 4. Imagine for a moment that you are Jesus and you are wrongly accused and you are being flogged. What would be running through your mind? Can you imagine being him and offering up forgiveness to those who were beating him?
- 5. Pilate brings Jesus out and shows off the beating he received. He is hoping for the sympathy of the crowd. The crowd is now more like a mob and they cannot use reason. Has there been a moment in which you acted in an unreasonable way because of the people you were around?
- 6. How might we understand Jesus' line about Pilate only having power that comes from God, especially in light of how governments throughout history have acted in inhumane ways? Why is it important to recognize God allowing governments to exist is different than God dictating what governments do?
- 7. Pilate knew the right thing to do was to set Jesus free, but he did not do it. What is the area of your life that is hardest for you to do the right thing?
- 8. This week, ask God to reveal to you if there is an area of "cognitive dissonance" (an area where you may compromise the right thing because you don't like the implications of it) in your life.
