1. Read John 3:22-24. What was the difference between Jesus’ baptism and the baptism of John? What did John the Baptist do once Jesus began His ministry? How can this challenge you in your life?

2. Read John 5:25-26. What was it that John the Baptist’s disciples were struggling with? How do Num. 11:26-30; Lk. 9:49-50; and Phil. 1:15-18 show a similar theme? Have you ever had these struggles of comparison? Please explain.

3. Discuss how comparison can lead to competition which can lead to insecurity in your life. How can reorienting your identity in Christ help you fight this tendency? (Gen. 1:27; Eph. 2:10)

4. Read John 3:27-28. What was John’s response to His disciples? How can we learn from that and apply this answer in our lives? (Jn. 6:65; 19:11)

5. Read 1 Cor. 3:3-7; 4:6-7. How do these passages fit in with our text?

6. Read John 3:29. Who is the bridegroom? Who is the bride? Who is the best man? Are you doing your duty as Jesus’ best man? Why or why not?

7. Read John 3:30. What are the three “musts” in John 3? How can you practically decrease as Christ increases in your life this week?

8. Read the take home questions. Which one encourages you or challenges you the most? Why? How will you grow and change in response to this sermon?
