“You are My Son”

Hebrew 5:4 to 8

Hebrews 5:4-5 TIL: *‘A high priest does not elect himself to that position. He must be called by God, just as Aaron was. Even Christ did not make Himself our high priest. He was appointed by God. God said to Him: ‘You are My Son; today I have become Your Father’.’*

Hebrews 5:5 CPV: *“So Christ didn’t just up and appoint Himself a spiritual leadership. God did it when He said to Him: ‘You are My Son; today I fathered You’.”*

Hebrews 5:5 TLB: *“That is why Christ did not elect Himself to the honor of being High Priest; no, He was chosen by God. God said to Him, ‘My Son, today I have honored You’.”*

Hebrews 5:5 TPT: *“So also, Christ was not self-appointed and did not glorify Himself becoming a high priest, but God called and glorified Him! For the Father said to Him, ‘You are My favored Son. Today, I have fathered You’.”*

Hebrews 5:5 MSG: *“Neither did Christ presume to set Himself up as high priest, but was set apart by the One who said to Him, ‘You’re My Son; today I celebrate You!’”*

Hebrews 5:7 NIV: *“During the days of Jesus’ life on earth, He offered up prayers and petitions with fervent cries and tears to the One who could save Him from death, and He was heard because of His reverent submission.”*

Hebrews 5:7 CPV: *“During those days when Jesus was a man, He agonized in prayer, sometimes with pained outcries and tears, pouring out His heart to the One who could have saved Him from such a death. And God listened to this kind of devout sincerity.*

Hebrews 5:7 CEV: *“God had the power to save Jesus from death. And while Jesus was on earth, He begged God with loud crying and tears to save Him. He truly worshiped God, and God listened to His prayers.”*

Hebrews 5:7 VOC: *“When Jesus was on the earth, a man of flesh and blood...”*
