Intro:

Revenge is usually well *thought* out and planned. It is seldom a *spur* of the moment reaction.

Absalom waited two *years* to get *revenge* from his older half-brother for the rape of *Tamar*.

Once again David was caught *off guard* concerning the purpose of Absalom's request.

2 Samuel 13:23-39

Intro:

Like David, Absalom had his *servants* kill Amnon. It was a *cowardly*, evil action.

The fallout was:

- 1. The other sons *feared* Absalom would kill them and took off for Jerusalem,
- **2.** Absalom fled to *Geshur*, the home of his mother, *Maacah*, the daughter of the king.

I. Revenge; What is it?

In the *Pentateuch* God gives guidelines regarding the use of *revenge*,

- 1. It is *never* to be individually implemented,
- 2. They are given to *restrain* man's vindictiveness, Ex. 21, Lev. 24, Deut. 19.
- 3. It is something He alone administers, Prov. 20, Deut. 32.

II. Our Response to Revenge

Seeking *revenge* is part and parcel to our fallen nature.

Three general attitudes to help us *defeat* the desire for *revenge*:

- 1. Don't *resist* an evil person, Vs. 39. Don't *retaliate*.
- 2. Practice *generosity*, Vs. 42. Along with discernment.
- 3. Be ______, teleios, (Gk.) or mature,

II. Our Response to Revenge

Seeking *revenge* is part and parcel to our fallen nature.

Three general attitudes to help us *defeat* the desire for *revenge*:

3. Be perfect, teleios, (Gk.) or mature, complete.

By loving our *enemies* we become like our Father in heaven. Rom. 5:8; 1 John 4:19.

II. Our Response to Revenge

Four things to show love instead of *revenge*:

- 1. Don't respond to *insults*, don't retaliate, Vs. 39. Prov. 12:6; 1 Peter 3:9
- 2. Do more than what's *required* for reconciliation, vs. 40. Lk. 19:8
- **3.** Treat mistreaters with *kindness*, Vs. 41, Col. 3:23.
- **4.** Don't show *favoritism*, **Vs. 42**. Not just our *money*, but in every area of our life.
