JOHN 15:1-16 part 11

"RELATIONSHIP" (part 2)

John 15:9-11 TPT: Jesus said to His disciples: (9) "I love each of you with the same **LOVE** that the Father **LOVES** Me. You **MUST CONTINUALLY** let My **LOVE NOURISH** your hearts. (10) If you keep (obey) My commands, you **WILL LIVE** in My **LOVE**, just as I have kept (obeyed) My Father's commands, for I **CONTINUALLY LIVE NOURISHED** and **EMPOWERED** by His **LOVE**. (11) My purpose for telling you these things is so that the **JOY** that I **EXPERIENCE WILL FILL** your hearts with **OVERFLOWING GLADNESS!**"
