Hebrew 2:10

HEBREWS 2:10 KJV: “For it became Him, for whom all things, and by whom are all things, in bringing many sons (and daughters) unto glory, to make the Captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings.

HEBREWS 2:10 TIL: “All things were made by God and for God’s purpose. His purpose was to bring many men as His sons, to glory. To carry out His purpose, God made His Son Jesus perfect through suffering. This was proper because, by suffering for us, Jesus was able to save us.”
