Text: John 3:14–21

Topic(s): Death of Jesus, Cross, Forgiveness, Redemption

Big Idea of the Message: Sin has infected the world, and Jesus alone is the remedy. **Application Point:** Jesus's death was the only way we could have redemption. To

accept this is to accept our role in Jesus's death.

Discussion Questions:

- 1. What is one thing that stood out to you from this week's message?
- 2. What does it mean to be born again? Why was this concept so difficult for Nicodemus to grasp? Do you think the same is still true? Why or why not?
- 3. What did Jesus mean when he said, "No one has ascended into heaven except he who descended from heaven, the Son of Man" (John 3:13)? How does this help us understand him better (see also 1:51)?
- 4. How is Jesus's crucifixion similar to putting a snake on a pole (see Numbers 21:4–9)? What does it say about God's way of dealing with evil and sin in our world?
- 5. In what ways might focusing on the death of Jesus during Lent help us better explain the concept of "eternal life"?
- 6. How can we pray for you?
