- 2. What are the things in your life that bring you the greatest anxiety?
- 3. Read 1 Peter 5:6-11
- 4. What jumps out to you from the text?
- 5. Peter writes of being humble under God's authority. Why is it often hard to trust our whole selves, family, and future to God? When we don't trust everything to God, we are not putting ourselves under God but beside or even above him.
- 6. What do you think Peter means by "alert and sober minded"
- 7. How might you and I resist the devil (principalities and powers of darkness, deceptive ideas)?
- 8. Why does Peter mention twice in this passage that followers of Jesus will suffer? What is the benefit of suffering?
- 9. Spend time daily this week with Jesus. Read the words of the Sermon on the Mount each morning and reflect on them (Matthew 5-7)
