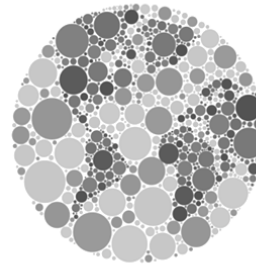

Main Idea: A person who receives the implanted word has a new heart that produces controlled speech, loving ministry, and a holy life.

1. The words you say are an accurate reflection of the genuineness of your faith. (vv. 26)

2. Genuine faith is demonstrated in loving ministry and a holy life. (vv. 27)
