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CHAPTER TWO

EFFECTS OF PRAYERLESSNESS

Prayerlessness is expensive.

The effects it has on the believer and those connected to him cannot be quantified.

Sometimes, the damage prayerlessness causes becomes irreversible for some believers.

That is why we must all be delivered from prayerlessness.

The Bible clearly states that when there is no prayer, things deteriorate and begin to need healing:

in prayer.

Dullness of spiritual senses

When you are prayerless, it leads to your spiritual senses being dull.

You do not hear God; your dream life disappears.

You are also not sensitive to the leadings of the spirit of God.

You do not even see what is obvious spiritually.

The reason why this is so is that in prayer, all your spiritual senses are activated.

Prayer is a spiritual activity and your spiritual senses are engaged when you pray.

The more you pray, the sharper your spiritual senses become.

The same analogy is spoken of for those who spend time in the word of God:

Heb 5:14 But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.

Hebrews 5:14

You exercise your spiritual senses in prayer.

When you stop praying, your spiritual senses begin to become dull.

The longer you stop praying, the duller your spiritual senses become.

You would not want to get to such a place else you will fall into obvious traps that can destroy you or your family.

Devil rises strong

When you are prayerless, the devil rises strong in your affairs.

He takes over all that concerns you because you are not exercising any authority over him.

Can you imagine a farm that has rodents and insects coming over and the farmer never sprays the farm with pesticides and insecticides?

The rodents and insects will have a field day and destroy as much as they want to destroy without

any form of resistance.

The devil is a thief and thieves are good in stealing, killing and destroying:

Joh 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.

John 10:10

In many ways, praying to destroy the works of the devil can be like the spraying of pesticides and insecticides on your farm.

It keeps the devil in check and stops him from destroying things in your life and that which con-

cerns you.

The devil must be resisted and one of the most
powerful ways to resist him is in prayer.

God asks us to submit to Him but to resist the
devil:

***Jas 4:7 Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist
the devil, and he will flee from you.***

James 4:7

Prayerlessness gives the devil a field day in your
life.

There is no resistance to his activities. He virtually
has a grand party at your expense.

The only reason that is so is because you have become prayerless.

Do not allow the devil to take charge of your farm to destroy it.

Rise up in prayer.

Things become slow

Whenever you become prayerless, things tend to be slow and virtually grind to a halt eventually.

The reason is simple.

When you pray, the heavens move. Angels are put to work on your behalf.

Their work brings results in different areas of

your life.

The work of angels is far superior to the work of men and ensures that things move on in your life.

When you become prayerless, your angels cease to work.

They become dormant and inactive.

The movement and results you got from their activities are lost as a result.

In effect, things become slow in your life and sometimes grind to a total halt.

Of angels, the Bible says:

Heb 1:14 Are they not all ministering spirits, sent

forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation?

Hebrews 1:14

Angels minister or work for those who will be heirs of salvation.

They are workers at the disposal of believers and they must be put to work.

Daniel knew how to put angels to work in prayer:

Dan 10:12 Then said he unto me, Fear not, Daniel: for from the first day that thou didst set thine heart to understand, and to chasten thyself before thy God, thy words were heard, and I am come for thy words.

Daniel 10:12

When you pray, angels work. Your prayerlessness is doing a lot of harm to your progress and the work of angels in your life.

Decide to remedy that situation. Start praying again. You will see increase and movement in your life.

Frustration and guilt

When you become prayerless, there is a feeling of guilt and frustration that engulfs you.

You will always feel there is something you should do but are not doing.

This guilt and frustration tends to creep into

other aspects of your life.

It can make you helpless and present a feeling of hopelessness.

This is part of the attacks of the enemy in your life.

He attacks you in many ways to gain the upper hand over you:

1Pe 5:8 Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:

1 Peter 5:8

Start praying now. Lift that burden of frustration and guilt.

It is not your portion.

Be quickened right now in Jesus name. Start praising God right now in the name of Jesus.

You are delivered from the spirit of frustration and guilt. Begin to sing and give thanks to God.

Glory.

Temptations overwhelm you

When you are prayerless, temptations overwhelm and overtake you.

Jesus in his wisdom advised us to watch and pray so that we do not enter into temptation.

When you are prayerless, you fall short of the

wisdom of Jesus and will fall into the predicaments he spoke about.

Many are falling into temptations and falling into many vices because they are not watching and praying.

There are problems all over them because they have become prayerless.

Mat 26:41 Watch and pray, that ye enter not into temptation: the spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak.

Matthew 26:41

A simple way to escape problems is to jump into an effective prayer life.

Let nothing stop you from taking a few minutes to pray right now.

You are stirring up that desire to pray.
