

#### Reflection:

- 1. Read Jonah 1:1-3, 12-16
  - a. Why do you think Jonah went away from where God was calling him?
  - b. When have you sensed God leading in a direction and you did not go?
  - c. Is there anything else that jumps out at you in the text?
- 2. Read Jonah 2:1-10
  - a. What were the things from the prayer of Jonah that stood out to you?
  - b. When have you felt like you were at your lowest?
- 3. Read Jonah 3:1-5, 10
  - a. What from this passage was most intriguing to you?
  - b. When is a time that God has been at work in a way you have seen?
  - c. Has God ever used you to change the lives of others?
- 4. Read Jonah 4:1-4
  - a. What are your initial thoughts from this section?
  - b. Is there a way that you find yourself struggling to see God's grace extended to a certain person or group of people? Why?
  - c. How can you become a person with compassion like that of God?

#### Application:

- 1. What is one way you could go where God is calling you?
- 2. What is one thing if you changed in your life you might see your compassion increase?
