WELCOME DR. LINDA SHARP, OUR NEW ORGANIST!

Linda A. Sharp is a native of Storm Lake, Iowa. She holds a B.A. in Keyboard Performance and Music Education from Buena Vista University, studio of Robbe Delcamp, and an M.A. and DMA in Organ Performance and Pedagogy from the University of Iowa, where she studied with Gerhard Krapf and Delbert Disselhorst. Sharp held a postdoctoral fellowship at Indiana University Bloomington in Organ Performance and Music Education, a student of Larry Smith, Organ, and Jean Sinor, an expert in Kodaly. In May 2003 she had her conducting debut at Carnegie Hall with the Northern University High School Choir (Price Lab School) in a solo prelude concert. The choir was accepted to sing at Washington National Cathedral, where Sharp played a solo prelude concert in August of 2006. Sharp directs musical theater for both the Cedar Falls Community Theater and the Waterloo Community Playhouse. She has a private voice and piano studio. She is currently finishing the ordination process in the Wesleyan church. Sharp, who resides in Cedar Falls, has three grown children and a three-year old grandson, as well as a rescue dog and cat.
