## **Further Reflection for 4/6**

- 1. Read Isaiah 43:16-21. What stands out to you from this passage? What is one idea that strikes you?
- 2. Have you ever found yourself living in the past? Do you tend to lean towards nostalgia or regret of the past? How have you let your identity be shaped by the past?
- 3. "I can learn from my past, I can honor my past, but I refuse to be imprisoned by my past." What do you think about this? How can we unchain ourselves from the past and look to what God is doing?
- 4. What does it mean that God is doing a new thing? What impact does this new thing have on our lives?
- 5. Read 2 Corinthians 5:17-21. What does it mean that we are a new creation through Christ?
- 6. Philippians 3:7-14. What does it look like to continue to strive after Christ? What does that mean for you in your day-to-day life?

The response from this passage is two-fold; we surrender and we participate. So what would it mean for you to surrender to Christ and to participate and embrace the new thing that God is doing?
