1. Read John 16:8-9. Who is coming? When does He come? What does the word “convict” mean? How does the the Holy Spirit convict the world of sin? (1 Cor. 14:24-25)

2. Read John 16:10. How would you define righteousness? What is the righteousness of Christ? How is that imputed to your account? (2 Cor. 5:21; 1 Cor. 1:30)

3. Read John 16:11. Who is the ruler of this world? How has he already been judged? (Jn. 12:31; Rev. 12:9) Why does the world judge Christians? (1 Cor. 1:18; 2:14)

4. Read John 16:12-13. How does the Holy Spirit guide the believer in all truth? (John 14:26; 15:15; Rom. 8:26)

5. Read John 16:14. How does the Holy Spirt glorify Christ? What does this look like in your life? (Col. 2:9; Jn. 15:26)

6. Read John 16:15. What does this verse teach us about about the Trinity? What does the Holy Spirit declare to us? (Matt. 28:18; Acts 1:80)

7. Read the take home questions. Which one encouraged you or challenged you the most? Why? How will you live your life differently this week based on what you have learned from this passage?
