Put off the Doctrine of the World

(2:16-23)


Three Reasons to Put off the Doctrine of the World...

- 1. Its Matters Are Artificial (2:16-17)
 - Artificial because the matters are only <u>physical</u> (2:16a)
 - Artificial because the matters are only <u>temporal</u> (2:16b)
 - Christ is <u>substantial</u> in all these ways (2:17)



Put off the Doctrine of the World

(2:16-23)



Three Reasons to Put off the Doctrine of the World...

- 2. Its Methods Are <u>Unproductive</u> (2:18-19)
- •Unproductive because it makes you <u>delight</u> in all the wrong things (2:18a)
- •Unproductive because it makes you <u>focus</u> on all the wrong things (2:18b)
- •Unproductive because it makes you <u>boast</u> in all the wrong things (2:18c)
 - Christ is <u>effective</u> in all these ways (2:19)

Put off the Doctrine of the World

(2:16-23)

Three Reasons to Put off the Doctrine of the World...

- 3. Its Mandates Are Worthless (2:20-23)
 - Worthless because of its lack of <u>durability</u> (2:22a)
 - Worthless because of its lack of credibility (2:22b)
 - Worthless because of its lack of <u>capability</u> (2:23)
 - Christ is <u>valuable</u> in all these ways (2:20-21)
