- Read Ruth 4:13-22
 - a. Why is the genealogy listed in these verses significant?
- What are the things that you are most insecure about in your relationship with Jesus? Are these insecurities holding you back from "clinging" completely to Him?
- 6. How is Jesus Christ your ultimate redeemer?
- 7. Pray: "Father, you are my redeemer. Help me to cling to the truth of who you are and who you say I am. In Jesus' name I pray, Amen."
