
Things You Should Know!

Further Reflection for 7/4

- 1. Read each passage and reflect on the way you see God listening to the cries of his people, rescuing his people, or the way in the people chose to go away from God.
- 2. Read Judges 2:10-23. Can you see the patter that shows oppression, repentance, deliverance, failure? If so, divide up the verses in that pattern
- 3. Read Judges 6-8, when did Gideon make the right choice and when did Gideon compromise?
- 4. Read Judges 13-16, when did Samson compromise?
- 5. Read Judges 17:6, 18:1, 19:1, and 21:25. What is the significance of these texts in understanding Israel as God's unique people.
- 6. Pray this prayer: "Father, help me to worship you alone. Help me to be aware of these ways in which I am being, have been, or will be tempted to compromise in my faith. In Jesus' name I pray, Amen."
