James 1:22 says, *“But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves.”* These questions are designed to help you apply today’s message to your life. We encourage you to thoughtfully answer these questions and discuss your answers with others. 1. Read John 19:23-24. Why did the soldiers cast lots for Jesus’ tunic? How was this a fulfillment of Psalm 22:18? Why is that so important?

2. Was Jesus crucified naked? What are your thoughts about that? How do Gen. 3:6-7; 1 Pet. 5:5; Deut. 22:5; 1 Tim. 2:9; 6:8; Matt. 17:2; Rev. 6:11; Isa. 61:10; and Rev. 3:18 help you develop a theology of clothes from the Bible?

3. Read John 19:25. Why were these four women there at the foot of the cross? How does Jn. 4:27; 8:10; Lk. 7:12; Matt. 9:22; Lk. 13:12; 23:28; and Lk. 2:35 show how Jesus respected women?

4. Read John 19:26-27. How did Jesus honor Mary with His last words? How do we honor our parents as they get older?

5. Read John 19:28-29. What is the importance of Jesus’ statement, “I thirst”? Read Matt. 27:34, 45-46; Psa. 69:21; Jn. 18:11; Ex. 12:22. Discuss the importance of why Jesus drank one wine but would not drink the other?

6. Read John 19:30. What does Jesus mean by saying “It is finished”? Did anyone take Jesus’ life from Him? (Jn. 10:17-18; Gal. 2:20; Mk. 10:45; Eph. 5:2)

7. Read the take home questions. Which one challenges you or encourages you the most? How will you live differently this week based on what you have learned from this text?
