	F	The answer is diligence—staying and diligent. We can tell whether we are diligent or lazy by asking ourselves a few questions:
	✓	Do we diligently listen to the WORD preached or taught \underline{OR} are we lazy, allowing our minds and thoughts to wander around?
	✓	Do we diligently read and study God's WORD in our daily worship and devotional time OR are we complacent (self-satisfied) and lazyish (idle, inactive) to worshiping God on a daily basis.
	✓	Do we diligently pray every day—really pray— $\overline{\text{OR}}$ are we complacent (self-satisfied) and neglected in prayer?
	✓	Do we diligently share Christ OR are we lazyish in sharing Him?
	✓	Are we diligent in our weekly worship of God in His church $\overline{\text{OR}}$ are we idle and complacent (self-satisfied) in our weekly worship?
