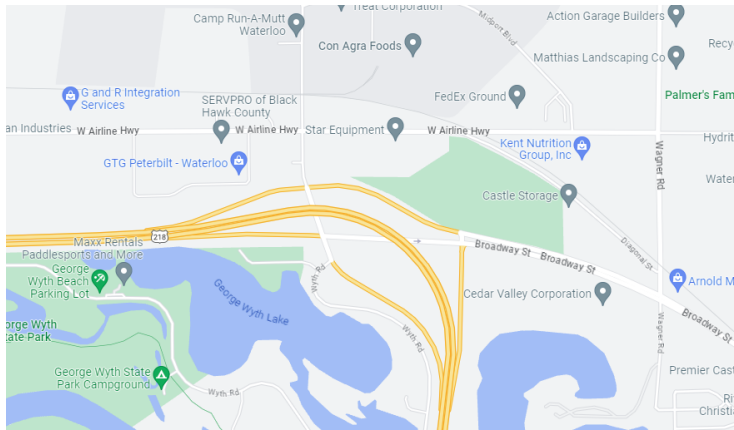
THE FOOD NOOK
