I. The Invitation

B. Invitation to sinners:

There are two traits that lead a sinner to repentance;

- He must be one who thirsts.
 (Thirst is a recognition of spiritual need.)
- 2. He must desire to have that need met.

II. The Incentives

- **A.** Because of the Person of Christ;
 - 1. He is infinite and eternal,
 - 2. He is the author and source of salvation,
 - **3.** He is exalted above all others.
- **B.** Because of the exclusivity of heaven, (Only the redeemed will be able to enter Heaven)

II. The Incentives

- C. Because of the truthfulness of scripture, (God is Truth, His word is therefore true.)
- D. Because of the certainty of Christ's return, (God's past prophetic record is 100% accurate.)
