

Galatians 5:7-12

*Free to Run the Race*

1. The Christian life is a **race**. (v. 7a)
2. We run the **race** through obedience to the **truth**. (v. 7b)
3. False teachers distort the **truth** and contaminate the **church**. (vv. 8-10)
4. We must purge the **church** of false teaching in order to finish the **race** well. (vv. 11-12)
