HEARING ASSISTANCE DEVICES

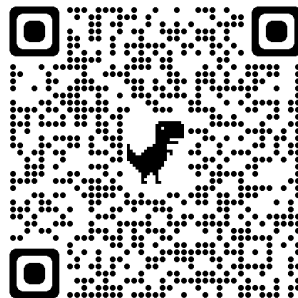
Are available, please ask an usher. At the end of the service please turn them off and return them to an usher.
