6. What jumps out to you from the text?
7. How often do you look wrongly at another person? Why do you think that is? How can you begin to see people as God sees them?
8. Read 1 Samuel 12:1-12
9. What jumps out to you from the text?
10. How does this story illustrate the ways "we" extend grace to ourselves but not others?
11. Full surrender to Jesus leads to life. Ask Jesus if there is an area of your life that you have not surrendered. Practice daily praying that God would help you examine your life.
