## Further Reflection for 6/9

1. What is a time when you were truly afraid? How did you make it through that moment?
2. Read John 6:16-24
3. What jumps out to you from the text?
4. Have you ever been on choppy dangerous waters? What ran through your mind?
5. What emotions do you think went through the disciples' mind when they saw Jesus walking on the water?
6. Jesus speaks to them and says, "It is I; don't be afraid." Most of the time we talk about fear in ways that are likely not what we are most afraid of. Usually, we bottle in our deepest fears. What are your deepest fears? (there is freedom in sharing them)
7. Once the disciples invited Jesus into the boat, they immediately made it to the other side. In other words, once they were fully invested in Jesus, the chaos around them went away. Is there an area of your life that you have not surrendered to Jesus? If so, why?
8. This passage ends with the people going to search for Jesus. Share a moment when you have been searching for Jesus?
9. This week spend time talking with God about your greatest fears. Write them down and pray that you will be able to leave them with God.
