

Further Reflection - 1 John 4

- 1. Read 1 John 4
- How does John say that we are supposed to know what Spirit is from God?
- 3. What is hopeful about the idea that "the one who is in you is greater than the one who is in the world."? (verse 4)
- 4. Summarize verse 7 in your own words. Why is this verse so powerful?
- 5. When you read verses 16-18 what comes to mind? How might that impact the way we think of fear?
- 6. Verse 19 reminds us where the source of love is. Why might knowing the source better help us to love others?
- 7. Verses 7, 11, 19-21, all point out that we are called to love others. In fact, what becomes clear here and throughout the gospels is that love of others is not optional. If we are to love others as God loves us, what does that look like?
- 8. Pastor Aaron reminded us that the way we love others is inextricably linked to the way we love God. In other words, our love for God can be no greater than our love for others. Reflect
