Further Reflection for 6/6

1. Read Genesis 1-3
2. From Genesis 1, what jumps out to you? Genesis 2? Genesis 3?
3. Genesis 1 is an orderly account that shows a theological framework for creation. Days 1-3 are God separating things, Days 4-6 are days where God fills what he separates, Day 7 is a day of rest or blessing. How might that help us think about who God is and how he calls his people to live?
4. What are the things that people are called to live out BEFORE sin enters the picture? (In other words, what activities are a part of God's intention that we might have previously thought of as punishments.)
5. When you think about Genesis 3 and Adam and Eve choosing to go away from God's love and into sin. What are the greatest temptations for you in that regard?
6. Taking all three chapters together, what are some things you believe you can learn about God's character?
7. Pray this week, "Father, help me to choose love over control. May I recognize the moments that my temptation is to not trust God enough and try and make my own way. May love be the overflow of my life. In Jesus' name I pray, Amen."
