Message Title: How do we steal?

You shall not steal.

Exodus 20:15 NKJV
Deuteronomy 5:19 NKJV

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Listen to this, you that trample on the needy and try to destroy the poor of the country. You say to yourselves, “We can hardly wait for the holy days to be over so that we can sell our grain. When will the Sabbath end, so that we can start selling again?
