LBC God, Genesis, and Gender Part 1 Genesis 1-3

Genesis 1

This chapter gives us a general overview of the creation account.

In it we see that God created the universe:

- <u>Himself</u>. 1:1, 26.
- Supernaturally. 1:3, 6.
- In <u>24 hour blocks</u> of time. 1:5, 8.

Genesis 2

This chapter gives us a specific account of the creation of the garden and man.

In it we see that God created man:

- As a <u>functioning adult</u>. 2:15-20.
- As the pinnacle of His creative work. 1:31.
- As a being in <u>perfect harmony</u> with Himself. 2:25.

Genesis 3

This chapter gives us the temptation and fall of Adam and Eve.

In it we see the fall:

- Took place because Adam and Eve willingly chose to disobey God's command. 3:6.
- Required a <u>curse</u> by God. 3:14-19.
- Brought <u>death</u> and <u>destruction</u> to Adam and Eve plus all of <u>creation</u>. 3:19.

Some Concluding Thoughts

These chapters should be read as <u>history</u> and <u>theology</u>.

A straightforward reading of these chapters excludes any sort of <u>evolutionist</u> understanding of creation.

This text is foundational for a Christian worldview.
