

Further Reflection - 2 Peter 1

- 1. Read 2 Peter 1
- 2. Summarize verse 3 in your own words.
- 3. What do you think Peter means by the phrase "you may participate in the divine nature"?
- 4. Verses 5-7 speak of characteristics that should define the followers of Jesus. What characteristics are easy for you to lean into and which are a greater struggle?
- 5. Verse 9 speaks of being nearsighted and blind...when is a time you have been that in your faith? What changed?
- 6. Why might it be powerful for Peter to have been an eyewitness to not only the resurrection of Jesus, but to the moment of transfiguration in which God said, "This is my son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased."? What weight does that give Peter's words.
- 7. Prophets were less future-tellers and more truth-tellers. They were able to see clearly when others could not, would not, or did not want to do so. Why might understanding the prophetic voice be important?
