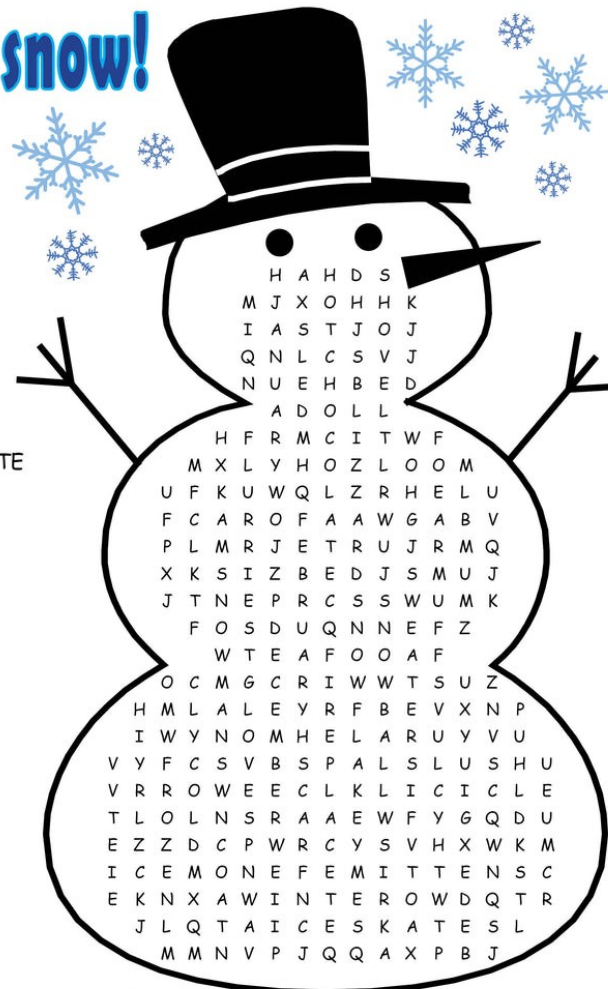

4. What does verse 2 point out in regards to the Old Testament (anytime in the Bible that Scripture is referred to, it is always pointing to that)?
5. Verses 3 and 4 address what was somewhat controversial in some groups in the beginning of Christianity. What are the two things about Jesus that Paul makes clear in these verses?
6. Summarize verses 5-7 in your own words.
7. This week, reflect on how Paul can go from persecutor of Christians to faithful follower of Jesus. How might that need to stretch your imagination? Spend some time reflecting on the impact of how Jesus impacts your daily life.
