JOHN 14:15-21 part 2

TODAY: Theme is "another Comforter"

John 14:15-21 KJV: TODAY is: (16) Jesus said, "And I will pray the Father, and He shall give you another Comforter, that He may abide with you forever;"

John 14:16 AMP: "And I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Helper (Comforter, Advocate, Intercessor—Counselor, Strengtheners, Standby), to be with you forever—"

John 14:16 DLNT: "And I will *request* the Father, and He will give you another Helper to be with you forever—"

1. Jesus, as a _____, will make a **REQUEST** in His disciples' interest.
2. Since Jesus has just used the verb "ask" in speaking of the prayers of the disciples and **NOW** shifts to the verb "_____" when He is thinking of His own prayer in their interest, it is obvious that the change in verbs was **INTENTIONAL**. The disciples were not a _____ with God's only begotten Son. They—disciples must implore; Jesus has a right to ask on terms of _____. On the other hand, in speaking of His own prayers, Jesus _____ uses 'request', _____ 'ask'.
3. **REMEMBER THIS: Luke 11:13:** "...how much more shall your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to them that _____ Him?" and the same thing Jesus said, "He shall give you another Comforter..." You shall receive the _____ of the Holy Spirit." (**Acts 2:38**)
4. Jesus' promise that in answer to His request the Father will give to the disciples *another 'Comforter'*.
 - ✓ The word 'another' means 'one like Myself who will take My place, do My work'.
 - Hence (from this source or origin), Jesus is a Person, the Holy Spirit must be a _____.
 - ✓ 'Comforter' in the Greek word 'paraclete'. It means '**someone who is called in**'.
 - ✓ This word 'com' means 'along side of' and 'fortis' means 'strong'. The Holy Spirit is the Strong One who abides with us forever.
 - The word also another defines 'fortis' -- 'brave'—a Comforter was Someone who enabled some dispirited creature to be brave.
 - We often talk of being able to _____ with things, that is precisely the work of the Holy Spirit. He takes away our inadequacies and _____ us to cope with life. The Holy Spirit _____ victorious for defeated living.

✓ “Holy” and “Spirit” _____ Him, but “Comforter” is His _____.

5. **First John 2:1 MEV:** “My little children, I am writing these things to you, so that you do not sin. But if anyone does sin, we have an **ADVOCATE** (Comforter, Intercessor, Helper, Counselor, Strengtheners, and Standby) with the Father, Jesus Christ the Righteous One.”

☞ Jesus Christ is Himself called “**Paraclete**”. He is the **Helper** in the sense of being **Advocate** or **Intercessor** with the Father in the interest of believers who commit sins.

- The second Helper (_____), moreover (in addition to what has been said; further; beside), having once arrived (at Pentecost), will **NEVER** _____ from the church in any sense whatever. Hence, Pentecost is **NEVER REPEATED**.
